**IF YOU PURCHASED A CELL PHONE FROM VERIZON WIRELESS, A  
CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT COULD AFFECT YOUR RIGHTS**

A proposed settlement has been reached in a class action proceeding alleging that Verizon Wireless installed software locks on its wireless phones to prevent them from being used with other wireless carrier networks. If you have or had a Verizon Wireless account and purchased a cell phone from Verizon Wireless, you may be a member of the class whose rights are affected by this settlement.

**TERMS OF THE PROPOSED SETTLEMENT**

The settlement requires Verizon Wireless to set the software lock code in most cell phones it sells to a default code and to disclose that code to purchasers. The settlement further requires Verizon Wireless to provide guidance and assistance to customers wishing to use a cell phone that they purchased from another company with Verizon Wireless's service. Unless you request to be excluded from the class, any claim that you may have against Verizon Wireless with respect to alleged locking of cell phones will be released. The attorneys for the class will also apply to the Court for approval to receive attorneys' fees and expenses of up to \$1.9 million, which Verizon Wireless has agreed to pay.

**YOUR RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN OR EXCLUDE YOURSELF FROM THE  
SETTLEMENT**

If you wish to participate in the settlement, you do not need to do anything at this point.

You may exclude yourself from the class by submitting a written exclusion request addressed to Munger, Tolles & Olson LLP, P.O. Box Number 194323, San Francisco, CA 94119-4323, postmarked no later than May 5, 2007.

Unless you request to be excluded from the class, you may appear at the settlement hearing to be held by the Court on June 4, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. to object to the settlement or to the application for attorneys' fees and expenses. To do so, you must file a written notice of objection, together with a statement of your reasons with the Court, at the above address with a copy to class counsel listed below, by no later than May 21, 2007.

Regardless of whether you stay in the lawsuit or exclude yourself, your cell phone service will not be affected. You may obtain more information about the settlement, including the settlement agreement and the Court's orders, by visiting [www.vzwcclphonesettlement.com](http://www.vzwcclphonesettlement.com) or by contacting counsel for the class (Law Offices of Scott A. 
